From our work with the Sierra Club and the Texas Civil Rights Project to strengthen a national coalition of environmental, faith, and human rights partners to fight the US-Mexico border wall, to our partnership with As You Sow to leverage shareholder advocacy to curb the overuse of antibiotics and pesticides on farms, we invest in solutions that secure a thriving planet for future generations.



## WOMEN ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERS

The Rachel's Network Catalyst Award annually awards mid-career women of color \$10,000 to acknowledge their leadership in the environmental movement. We also joined forces with Ashoka to provide funding to women environment entrepreneurs who are addressing our most serious challenges: Janelle Orsi, who is building legal infrastructure for the sharing economy, and Angelou Ezeilo, who is creating opportunities for diverse youth in conservation careers.



## GENDER PARITY IN POLITICS

Women comprise roughly 51 percent of the population and 53 percent of the electorate but only 23 percent of Congress. Since 2000, Rachel's Network has made the case that gender disparity in government not only stymies equality, it has serious implications for environmental policy as well. That's why we've funded efforts to increase the number of women in government through programs like Plate to Politics and regularly release our *When Women Lead* report revealing the superior environmental voting records of women in Congress.
